*For the purpose of this Permit and the terms and conditions specified below, the following definitions apply:*

**1. DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "Ministry" means the Ontario Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks.
- (b) "Pesticide" means the pest control products and associated Pest Control Products Act No. specified in this Permit
- (c) "Director" means any Ministry employee appointed by the Minister under *Section 3(1) of the Pesticides Act*.
- (d) "Permit" means this *Perform A Water Extermination* permit issued in accordance with *Section 7 of the Pesticides Act*.
- (e) "PCP No." means the Pest Control Products Act number.
- (f) "Size of Treatment Area" means the approximate surface area of the water body to which the application of the pesticide under this Permit is authorized.
- (g) "Maximum Application Rate" means the maximum label rate at which the pesticide may be applied to the water body.
- (h) "Amount of Pesticide to be applied" means the maximum amount of pesticide that is authorized to be used pursuant to this Permit.
- (i) "Treatments authorized" means the maximum number of treatments authorized by this Permit.
- (j) "Permit Holder" means Richard Maass o/o 1410035 Ontario Inc.
- (k) "Treatment Period" means the period of time during which this Permit authorizes the application of the specified pesticide to water, in conjunction with the conditions set forth

in section 3 of this Permit.

- (l) "Provincial Officer" means any person designated in writing by the Minister as a Provincial Officer pursuant to Section 17 of the Pesticides Act.

### **3. CONDITIONS**

3.1. The issuance of, and compliance with this Permit, does not:

- a) relieve the Permit Holder or any other person from any obligation to comply with any other applicable legal requirements, including the provisions of the Pest Control Products Act, and the Pesticides Act, and any regulations made thereunder; or
- b) limit in any way any authority of the Ministry, a Director, or a Provincial Officer, including the authority to require certain steps be taken or to require the Permit Holder to furnish any further information related to this Permit.

3.2. The Permit Holder shall ensure that a copy of this permit is provided to all property

owners prior to the commencement of the treatment.

- 3.3. The Permit Holder shall ensure all adjacent land-owners, lessees and/or affected parties are notified of the proposed treatment a minimum of 48 hours prior to the commencement of the treatment. This notification shall include information regarding the treatment date/time and restrictions on water use identified on the pesticide label.
- 3.4. Immediately prior to treatment, the Permit Holder shall ensure that signs/notices are erected which state the treatment date and time; the product being used; and water use restrictions identified on the product label. These signs/notices shall be sufficient to warn the public against using the water for swimming or animal consumption for 24 hours and human consumption or irrigation for five (5) days. The permit holder shall ensure that these signs remain in place for the duration of specified use restrictions and are removed by the sixth (6) day following treatment.
- 3.5. The Permit Holder shall ensure treatment is only performed in water fronting properties where the property owner has provided consent.
- 3.6. Treatment is authorized only in areas used for swimming or where weed growth is, or is likely to become, sufficient to interfere with the safe operation of water craft.
- 3.7. The use of Reward<sup>®</sup> for aesthetic purposes or for the treatment of emergent aquatic vegetation (i.e., cattails, bulrushes, water lilies, pickerelweed etc.) is NOT permitted.
- 3.8. Following treatment with Reward<sup>®</sup>, the Permit Holder shall take all reasonable measures to ensure that the treated water is not used for swimming or animal consumption for 24 hours and human consumption or irrigation for five (5) days.
- 3.9. The Permit Holder shall ensure any situations involving health or environmental effects or damage to property related to the treatment(s) authorized by this Permit is reported immediately to the local **Ministry's Peterborough District Office, 1-800-558-0595**; or if a pesticide spill occurs, to the **Spills Action Centre at 1-800-268-6060**.
- 3.10. The Permit Holder shall ensure that a summary reporting form is completed and returned to the attention of the Regional Pesticides Specialist, Ministry of the Environment, 1259 Gardiners Road, Unit 3, Kingston ON K7P 3J6; or by e-mail to Scott.Olan@ontario.ca, prior to **November 1, 2020**.
- 3.11. This Permit expires on **November 2, 2020**.

#### **4. APPEALS AND NOTIFICATION**

*In accordance with section 13(9) of the Pesticides Act, R. S. O. 1990, Chapter P. 11, as amended, you may by written notice served upon the Director require that the Director, within 3 days of receipt of such notice, vary, rescind or confirm his or her decision. The Director, within 3 days of receipt of such*

*notice shall serve or cause to be served upon you this decision together with his or her written reasons therefor and where the Director varies or rescinds the decision, the Director shall take such action as may be necessary to make the variation or rescission effective.*

*In accordance with section 13(10) of the Pesticides Act, R. S. O. 1990, Chapter P. 11, as amended, you may by written notice served upon the Director and the Environmental Review Tribunal, within 15 days of service upon you of the notice under section 13(9) of the Pesticides Act, request a hearing of the Environmental Review Tribunal.*
